

2010 CALVARY BAPTIST –SPONSORS’ RELEASE AND COVENANT

Covering: ALL ACTIVITIES ORGANIZED FOR BY CALVARY BAPTIST CHURCH, ITS STAFF, SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHERS, OR OTHERS UNDER THE DIRECTION OF CALVARY BAPTIST, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR OF 2010.

I understand that, in the event that I require medical or dental treatment while engaged in the activity, reasonable efforts will be made to contact the emergency names listed below; however, if they cannot be reached, I hereby consent and give my permission to the ministry's sponsor or any adult acting on behalf of the ministry with respect to the Activity, as agent for me, to consent to any X-ray examination, injections, anesthesia, medical, dental, or surgical diagnosis and treatment; and hospital care and treatment advised and supervised by a physician, surgeon, or dentist licensed to practice under the laws of the state where the services are rendered, either as an outpatient or in any hospital.

I understand that my insurance coverage will be used as primary coverage in the event medical intervention is needed. Coverage by Calvary Baptist through its accident policy will be used as a backup for what my insurance does not cover.

I understand all reasonable safety precautions will be taken at all times by Calvary Baptist and its agents during the events and activities. I understand the possibility of unforeseen hazards and know the inherent possibility of risk. I also agree not to hold Calvary Baptist, its leaders, employees, and volunteer staff liable for damages, losses, diseases, or injuries incurred during my participation in the 2010 activities and events.

I also understand that visual and audio recordings may be made of these activities, and can be used by Calvary Baptist as needed for publicity, announcements, scrapbooks, etc.

SPONSOR’S COVENANT

Sponsor Behavior standards:

1. Any physical, verbal or nonverbal sexual behavior with any student is inappropriate & forbidden.
2. Dating or “going out” with any high school student is forbidden.
3. Physical contact with students can only take place in public settings. For opposite sex students, a “shoulder to shoulder” hug is the limit of contact.
4. Sexual gestures or overtures a student makes to a sponsor must be reported to a staff member.
5. “Buddy systems” must be used when sponsors are with opposite sex students.
6. One-to-one talking/confrontations/comforting must occur in a public area.
7. Never drive alone with a student of the opposite sex in your vehicle. It is best to never drive alone with any minor.
8. If you absolutely must give a student of the opposite sex a ride– call another adult and inform them of who, where, and what time you are driving.
9. All suspicions of child or sexual abuse must be reported to a staff member. You are a mandated reported caring for minors.

Sponsors’ Teaching standards:

1. Sponsors will strive with Christ’s help, to live a lifestyle in accordance with God’s Holy Word, with an understanding that grace and forgiveness are available with true repentance.
2. Sponsors will adhere to Southern Baptist doctrines in their teaching. The Baptist Faith & Message (2000) provides an outline of our doctrines. Class materials purchased on their own should be from Lifeway, or cleared with a church staff member before using. Dan has numerous resources for teachers – don’t hesitate to ask.
3. For personal growth, and setting an example, Sponsors are **strongly encouraged** to be active in an age appropriate class that they do not teach, but are only a “student” of that class. (Sunday School, Discipleship Training, Adult or CS Bible Studies)
4. Sponsors should have regular attendance at weekly services, a bible study, and a positive attitude towards their fellow sponsors, students, and staff. A personal walk with Christ should also be evident to students, in daily quiet times, prayer life, and scripture memorization.

TURN OVER

SPONSORS ARE ALWAYS "IN-CHARGE" EVEN IF NOT THE "LEADER" OF AN EVENT. THIS IS A BIG RESPONSIBILITY. PLEASE STEP IN AND INTERVENE WITH STUDENTS ON SAFETY AND BEHAVIOR ISSUES.

Sponsors always have a direct line to Dan and the rest of the ministry staff. Please do not hesitate to share any type of concern directly with Dan. Good communication saves many headaches and misinterpretations.

By completing this form you are consenting to a background check. The staff of Calvary Baptist has the right to complete background checks of sponsors, and may request sponsors not to serve if they do not meet the spirit of this covenant, or if the sponsor may pose a risk to individuals and ministries of Calvary Baptist.
